After you have affectively answered the four key questions, please list your color formulation. Include the brand of color, level and tone, amount of color and developer, application method and processing time.

You will be sharing your answers and color formulation with table mates for their critique and feedback. After the critique and feedback have been entered, you may adjust your formulation based on given advice.

Your final formulation for each quadrant should be entered and highlighted with a different text color and notated as "Final Formulation".

Critique & Feedback:

Tablemate should include name and if they agree with the color formulation. If they do not agree with the color formulation they should include suggestions for altering the formulation.

Haircolor Application and Results

On the following pages you will enter your step-by-step photos and instructions for the hair color formulation, application and results.

Photos should include one before photo of the quadrant, at least two application photos, One photo at the completed application and one photo of the finished quadrant after drying.

You will do this a minimum of four times, once for each quadrant. If I quadrant requires multiple applications you will repeat this process for each application. For example: if you apply a base color, process and then dry followed by applying for oils for highlights or low lights you will repeat this process for both applications. The same is true if you were going to pre-lighten the hair followed by toning or a fashion color application.

4 questions

- 1. How to know which colors to use when formulating- always use a shade under the original color bc if you used the exact color you want, the hair will turn out darker than what you wanted.*
- 2. How do I know how much product to use?- read the ratio charts on the paull mitchell or pop XG color charts*
- 3. How do I know warm from neutral?- the colors say a number with either a "N" or "W" ex: 7N or 7W*
- 4. How do I know how long to let bleach or color to sit before rinsing?- The color charts or box you used shuld tell the time, if not jjst go back every few mins to see how much the color and/or bleach has processed*



I first started with the gray quadrant, which all I had to do was bleach it with a 30 volume. It turned into a perfect light/pale blonde so the turquoise pop XG came out perfect my first try.

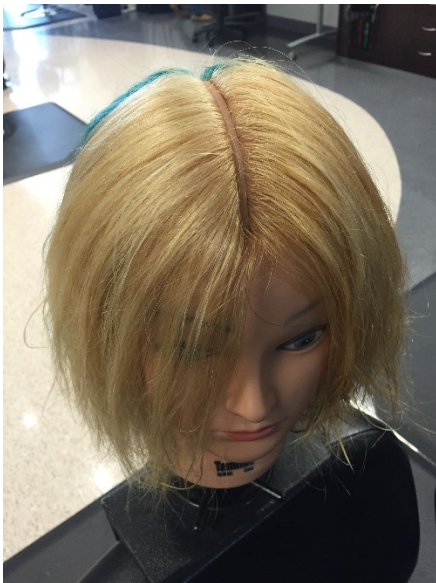




Next I did the back left quad which was black, so I bleached it with 40 volume and it didn't get blonde enough so bleached again with 30 volume, turned into a light yellow blonde which made the turquoise come out a bit greener than the right side.



Last I bleached the front quads with 30 volume which let the turquoise show up really well
